Hailing from Cape Town, he has assumed leadership roles in Human Resources, Organizational Transformation, and various strategic positions across several prominent listed and unlisted companies, including African Equity Empowerment Investments, Mustek, Premier Fishing, Sizwe IT Group, and the Community Schemes Ombud Service (CSOS).

In the realm of public service, Dr. Mehana was appointed by South Africa's Minister of Police Services to lead a transformation task team dedicated to professionalizing and demilitarizing the South African Police Service (SAPS), in accordance with the recommendations of the Marikana Commission.

Additionally, he served as a Ministerial appointee on the Governing Council of the University of KwaZulu-Natal, where he also held the position of chair during his tenure.

He has also earned various advanced management qualifications from prestigious institutions, including INSEAD, the National University of Singapore, and the London Graduate School.
